Walk difficulty:

Easy – gentle up hill on to Pitton Down

Dogs under control can be off a lead.

Start Grid Reference:

OS Sheet 184 SU 211 314

Walk description:

From the Silver Plough or the Village Hall walk along The Green (opposite the Hall) to where it becomes a narrow marked Bridleway.

After 300 yards turn right on to an unmade track. A steady climb leads to an open field with far-reaching views.

There is a circular walk around the edge of the field returning to the track. The path passes the remains of a World War II bunker.

Retrace the path to the Silver Plough.
