

Pitton Village Hall – 100 Club

- 1) The club will consist of a maximum of 100 members from Pitton and the surrounding area.
- 2) The club will be registered with Wiltshire Council as a Non Commercial Small Lottery and the relevant returns will be made on an annual basis.
- 3) Members may purchase more than one ticket.
- 4) The club year will start on 1st January each year, when the subscription becomes due.
- 5) The annual subscription of £100 p.a. or £9 p.m. will be collected by standing order.
- 6) There will be four prize draws per annum, all held in the village hall. At each draw free drinks and nibbles will be provided to those members present. Members may bring their partner/spouse for a fee to be decided, from time to time, by the committee.
- 7) The prize draws will be held on the first Sunday in April, July, October and the second Sunday in January. The doors will open at 12:30pm and the event will close at 1:30pm.
- 8) At each prize draw there will be 9 numbers drawn, with the holders of the numbers drawn receiving (only) one of the following prizes:
 - 7 x £100 prizes
 - 1 x £250 prize
 - 1 x £500 prizeThese prizes will be awarded in the order of the highest amounts first.
- 9) An individual number can only be drawn once at each draw event.
- 10) In the event that the number of members, as calculated on the day before a particular draw event, is less than 100 – the values of the prizes will be reduced on a pro rata basis. For example, if we have 80 members the value of prizes awarded will be reduced by 20% to be:
 - 3 x £80 prizes
 - 1 x £160 prize
 - 1 x £400 prize
- 11) Under the terms of the Gambling Act 2005 at least 20% of the proceeds of a Small Lottery must be applied to the purposes of the society. Therefore, in the event that the number of members is less than 60, as calculated on the day before a particular draw event, the club will be closed and the subscriptions received returned on a pro rata basis to the draws made at that time.
- 12) With the exception of Rule 11, these rules can be amended by a vote of all members where the majority of those voting will carry the resolution.
- 13) Communication to members will be deemed to have been delivered if sent by email. It will be the responsibility of a member to ensure that any change of email address is notified to the Lottery organiser.
